

Vermilionville's Gingerbread House Contest

Bake and decorate your favorite Vermilionville house or feature in gingerbread for fun and prizes!

Three divisions (may be baked / built by an individual or group):

Children 14 years and under

Adults 15 years and over

Professionals – working in cake/cookie decorating

Your gingerbread house must depict a building, structure or feature of Vermilionville/Bayou Vermilion District. All entrants will receive a pass to visit Vermilionville to decide on their gingerbread house subject.

Gingerbread houses may be submitted December 6 -9th at Vermilionville.

During Vermilionville's Old Time Winter December 12 -16, guests will have an opportunity to vote for their favorite gingerbread house.

Judging will be held at 10 AM on December 17, during our Old Time Winter Family Day. Winners will be announced at noon.

Gingerbread House Rules & Tips

1. Only edible items are allowed on the house / project
2. Houses must fit on a 24" x 24" board.
3. All entries must be at Vermilionville no later than 4 PM on December 9, 2022
4. Houses are exhibited December 10 – 17, 2022.
5. No names will be exhibited on projects; each entrant will be given a number to place with their house/project.
6. All entrants will receive a pass to visit Vermilionville to determine the subject of their project.
7. Projects may be undertaken individually or as a team. Only ONE project may be submitted per entrant.
8. Categories: Children 14 and under; Adults 15 and over; Professional working in cake/cookie decorating
9. Best in each division and People's Choice will receive awards.
10. Judging 10 AM on Saturday, December 17, our Old Time Winter Family Day. Winners will be announced at noon.
11. Entrants may pick up their houses after December 17 during regular museum hours, 10 AM – 4 PM Tuesday – Sunday.
12. Houses not removed by December 21 will be disposed of.

GUIDELINES

1. All entries must be handmade and depict a building, structure or feature of Vermilionville – Bayou Vermilion District. No artificial interior materials, such as wood or Styrofoam are to be used to construct or decorate the house.
2. Entire display must be made of edible materials, at least 50% gingerbread. Entries may use lollipops with paper or plastic sticks/stems. **ONLY ROYAL ICING SHOULD BE USED.** Buttercream frosting will spoil.
3. All entries must be on a heavy cardboard or wooden base, no larger than 24" x 24". No decorations or icing may be on the sides of the base.
4. Entries will be judged on imagination, construction, uniformity in baking and overall design.
5. Vermilionville reserves the right to use entrants' names, likeness and entry on website, social media and other promotional purposes.
6. Non-edible decorations, lights, figurines etc. may only be used to enhance your base.
