- A final count as well as any dietary restrictions should be submitted at least 48 hours prior to the date of the visit.
- A deposit of 50% of the meal cost is due 2 weeks prior to the date of the trip. Failure to pay deposit may result in the cancellation of your group's reservation.
- We ask that teachers and parents refrain from ordering individual meals through the restaurant during your visit, and instead enjoy lunch with your student.
- Meals are scheduled for 30 minutes – the timing of your lunch will depend on several factors, including the number of students/ teachers/ parents, other scheduled activities, students' usual lunch times, as well as arrival and departure times.
- Cold meals (options 1 and 2) are served in bags and can be eaten here in the Performance Center or taken on the road, while hot meals (options 3 and 4) are served in our Performance Center only and may require additional time for service depending on the number of students as well as their ability to walk with their own plate/ bowl of gumbo.
